## JLC/4-H/FFA WORK DUTIES

- 4-H & FFA Leaders/Advisors are responsible for assigning work details within their club/chapter. Please, match worker to duty required.
- Exhibitors must report to the front porch of JLC office 10 minutes before work detail begins for instructions and official sign in unless otherwise stated.
- Exhibitors are not to leave work detail until released by JLC Official.
- Workers must be 12 years or older.
- A late or no show of a club or chapter will result in a club/chapter fine of \$50.00 per offense.
- The division champions will receive a \$50.00 individual fine (assessed on auction sale amount) for not appearing for scheduled work duties.
- Workers need to supply their own tools: i.e. rakes, hoses, and brooms.
- Washing of bean pots, cleaning of swine wash racks and other duties as deemed necessary may also be directed.
- All Exhibitors – Are responsible in keeping your pens, show ring and bleachers clean of cups and debris through Fair Week.
